1. Help lay Marley studio floors and move portable ballet barres at the beginning and end of the program.*
2. Help maintain the floors during the CPYB 5-Week Summer Ballet Program with mopping, re-taping, etc., once per week.
3. Clean studio mirrors about once per week.

***Students should not accept this scholarship if they intend to leave the program early. Students cannot depart before 4 p.m. on July 28, 2012. The student's account will be billed \$680 if the student departs without completing his scholarship duties.**

The weekly duties are normally scheduled during the weekend and only take a few hours, depending on the total number of male students involved.

Please note that if the student receives a tuition scholarship award as well, an additional once-a-week cleaning duty will be assigned.

Work/Study Scholarship notes:

- Work/Study Scholarship awards are for students who will be attending the entire CPYB 5-Week Summer Ballet Program only and are limited to assistance with tuition.
- Students receiving a work/study scholarship award accept the responsibility of performing age appropriate duties (mostly cleaning) around the studios. Duties will be assigned shortly after the student's arrival.
- The non-refundable \$300 deposit is required of all applicants to reserve their places in the 5-Week Summer Ballet Program. However, the deposit will be returned to those students who apply for work/study assistance and are turned down or do not receive sufficient aid enabling them to attend. In these cases, students must notify CPYB in writing on or before MARCH 15, 2012, that they are unable to attend the 2012 5-Week Summer Ballet Program because of financial reasons.
- CPYB does not keep your tax information on file after the scholarship review process; your information is shredded and disposed of.
