Program

Summer students participate in a comprehensive curriculum of 16 or more ballet classes per week that bring together the finest in technique and artistry. Course work includes Ballet Technique, and for those who qualify: Pointe, Variations, Partnering, Modern and Men’s class. Optional supplemental classes, encompassing fitness and other genres of dance, provide the opportunity for dancers to expand their base of training knowledge and experience other forms of dance.

Housing
